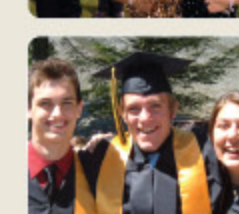
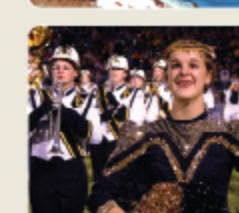
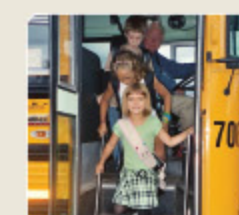
- TCAPS' school district includes 13 elementary schools, two middle schools, and three high schools.
