Why: Educational benefit is language in the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and tracking a student's progress toward their IEP goals is imperative.

What: Aimsweb (elementary/middle school) and Star Renaissance (high school) for students who receive Special Education in the areas of reading and math.

How: Special Education teachers and Northwest Education staff collaborate three times per year to review data.

b. Cell Phone Policy Implementation Plan Update

Administration provided an update on the supply implementation for the revised cell phone policy.

Kristin Perkowski, Associate Superintendent of Curriculum & Instruction, gave an update on the Safety Matters Programming.
