1. CALL TO ORDER AT 4:00 PM

Trustee Moon Mohr called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM.

2. PUBLIC COMMENT

3. VISUAL PERFORMING APPLIED ARTS PRESENTATION (PART 2)

Part 2 of the TCAPS Visual, Performing, and Applied Arts (VPAA) presentation was shared with the Board Curriculum Committee. This presentation spotlighted the excellent programs in place and focused on how updated equipment and renovated work spaces would increase interest in the programs and improve the quality of student performance. The VPAA department requested consideration in pre-bond planning as it relates to Digital Media/Journalism, Visual Fine Arts, and STEM/CTE.

c. 2022-23 TCAPS District Course Catalog Updates

Heidi Maltby-Skodack, Executive Director of School Improvement & Innovative Programs, informed Committee members that there are no proposed changes to the 2022-23 TCAPS District Course Catalog at this time.

d. Anatomy & Physiology - Adoption of Fundamentals of Anatomy & Physiology

Heidi Maltby-Skodack and Kelly Smith, Anatomy and Physiology Teacher, discussed the proposed Anatomy & Physiology adoption with Committee members. The proposed adoption selection is for *The Fundamentals of Anatomy and Physiology (12 Edition)*. This is for a six-year adoption with online resources. It was a unanimous choice by the team and provides additional opportunities for project based–learning. The Board of Education will act on this item at its June 12, 2023, regular scheduled meeting.

e. English Language Arts (ELA) - Continuation of My Perspective

Kirsten Jones-Morgan, Executive Director of Student Achievement, and Jody Meyers, ELA Curriculum Specialist, discussed the proposed English Language Arts adoption with Committee members. The proposed adoption is to continue the contract with *My Perspectives* from Savvas for grades 6-11. The six-year contract included individual digital and consumable resources and will have an update in 2025. The Board of Education will act on this item at its June 12, 2023, regular scheduled meeting.

f. Health & Physical Education (PE) - Adoption of Essentials in Health

Kirsten Jones-Morgan, Doug Glee, Teacher and Health & PE Curriculum Specialist, and Dan McGee, Teacher and Sex Education Curriculum Specialist, discussed the proposed Health & Physical Education adoption with Committee members. It is being recommended that a six-year adoption that includes digital access and resources be supported for *Comprehensive Health Skills* from Goodheart-Wilcox. The Board of Education will act on this item at its June 12, 2023, regular scheduled meeting.

g. State Benchmark Reporting - End of Year

Heidi Maltby-Skodack presented the TCAPS Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Goal Reporting to the Committee. The data presented showed gains in almost all areas.
