Traverse City Central High School has established the TC Central Hall of Fame for the following purpose as stated in the Hall of Fame By-laws.

It is expected that the achievements of persons selected for the HALL OF FAME will be above and beyond the ordinary."

The following are additional requirements for consideration of nominees:

- 1. Must be respected by their peers.
- 2. Must be outstanding in their field, and recognized by their community.
- 3. Former students must have attended TC Central High School for a minimum of two years.
- 4. Former staff members must have worked a minimum of five years at TC Central High School.
- 5. Living inductees must be present at the induction ceremony during Homecoming Weekend in the year they are selected.

- 1. A typewritten statement by the nominator, which will include a photo of the nominee.
- 2. Three additional typewritten statements of support, not to exceed two pages each.
- 3. The typewritten statements should explain how this person has met the requirements for entrance in the HALL OF FAME. They should include service to society, achievements, honors, family, etc., during years at TC Central High School and beyond.
