

Details surrounding COVID-19 change rapidly. As a district, we are committed to remaining flexible and will abide by state mandates that may occur or change throughout the academic year. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate a safe academic year for all.



### Masks

TCAPS Board of Education made the determination to require masks in school buildings based on recommendations for universal indoor masking from both the CDC and MDHHS. Medical waivers must be completed by a certified physician. The Board of Education will re-evaluate the mandate on an ongoing basis.

Masks are required on all buses, per CDC order.



### Sports

For outdoor sports, masks are not required. For indoor sports, masks are required when not actively participating.



### Vaccines

TCAPS will not mandate COVID-19 vaccines.



### Cleaning & Disinfecting

TCAPS will continue to disinfect all rooms on a daily basis. Cleaning supplies and hand sanitizer will be available and safely stored in every classroom.



### Monitoring Symptoms

Families should screen each child daily before coming to school. Students should not attend school or school activities/sports when COVID-19 symptoms are present.



### Visitors & Volunteers

Effective Sept. 28, 2021, TCAPS welcomes visitors and volunteers, as needed. All visitors must be masked when indoors and free of COVID-19 symptoms.



### Quarantine

TCAPS will continue to contact trace in partnership with our local health department. Contact tracing is determined as any individual who was in close contact of 3 feet for a cumulative of 15 minutes with an infected individual. All close contact will be notified by the Grand Traverse Health Department.
