### Reconfirmation Meeting for December 2020

<b>Reconfirm instructional delivery method</b>
TCAPS continues to utilize three platforms for instructional delivery during the month of December under Pandemic Learning. Remote teaching has been utilized for classrooms where either the student(s) and/or teacher have had to quarantine or self-isolate. Beginning December 11th, TCAPS secondary schools, grades 6-8, moved to remote instruction due to limitations with staff impacted by COVID-19 quarantine. Per the new Emergency Order 333.253, students 9-12 remained in remote learning. Licensed programming, including GSRP, and Categorical programming continue to meet face-to-face.

<b>Elementary (Grades K - 5):</b> K-5 students are enrolled in one of the following learning platforms Face-to-face: 3165 UpNorth Virtual Live: 355 UpNorth Virtual On-Demand: 241
<b>Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):</b> 6-8 students are enrolled in one of the following learning platforms Face-to-face: 1658 UpNorth Virtual Live: 159 UpNorth Virtual On-Demand: 166
<b>High School (Grades 9 - 12):</b> 9-12 students are enrolled in one of the following learning platforms Face-to-face: 2813 UpNorth Virtual Live: 105 UpNorth Virtual On-Demand: 307
