Dear Traverse City High School Families,

With the upcoming transportation service disruptions to high school afternoon bus routes, BATA will offer options to students in need of transportation. Options include:

- Daily: TCHS students may access the Bayline eastbound daily from the CTC BATA stop towards East Bay and the Bayline westbound daily at 3 Mile / US31. Both routes run back to downtown TC and Hall Street Transfer Station (every 25 minutes). (See map)
- **On Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays**, a BATA bus arrives at TCHS at 3:00 p.m. with service to the Hall Street Transfer Station. From there, students can connect to 3:30 p.m. routes. If you plan to use this shuttle, <u>please sign up here</u>.

Routes provided by Bay Area Transportation Authority (BATA) is a free service to students if:

- the student responds to the survey linked next to their route by Thursday, January 19, 2023 at 9:00 p.m.
- the student presents their TCAPS student ID at pick-up

(free rides <u>do not</u> apply to BATA's Link On-Demand services)

To determine which BATA service might work best for you, click the route information details provided:

- Students who utilize WSH transportation can access BATA route information here.
- Students who utilize CHS transportation can access BATA route information here.

As a reminder, from January 23rd - February 10th, TCAPS transportation services will be as follows:

- Central High School (CHS) Bus Routes (CHS & TCHS students)
 - Jan. 23, 24, 30, 31, Feb. 3, 6, 7 AM & PM busing offered
 - Jan. 25, 26, 27, Feb. 1, 2, 8, 9, 10 AM busing only
- West Senior High School Bus Routes (WSH & TCHS students)
 - Jan. 25, 26, 27, Feb. 1, 2, 8, 9, 10 AM & PM busing offered
 - Jan. 23, 24, 30, 31, Feb. 3, 6, 7 AM busing only
